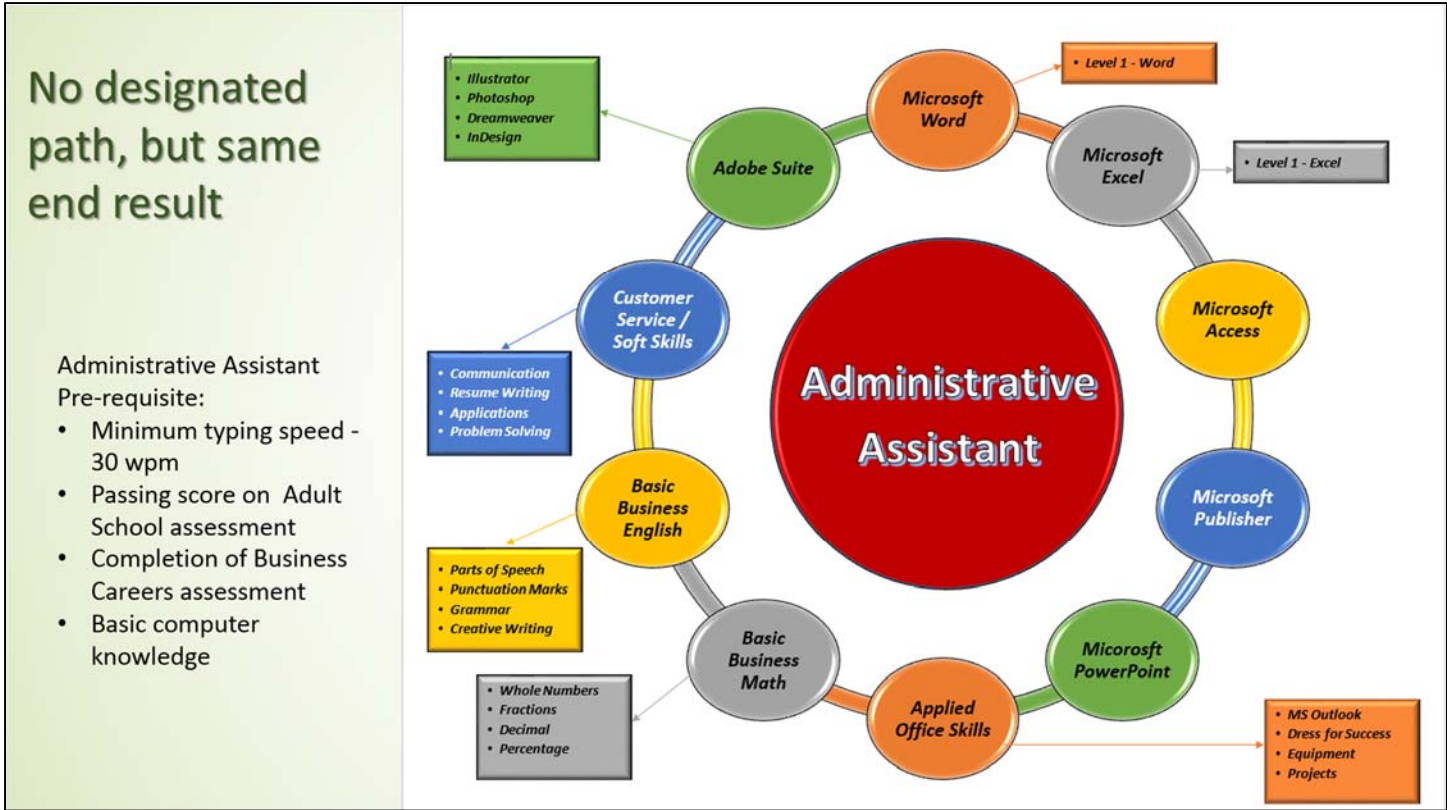

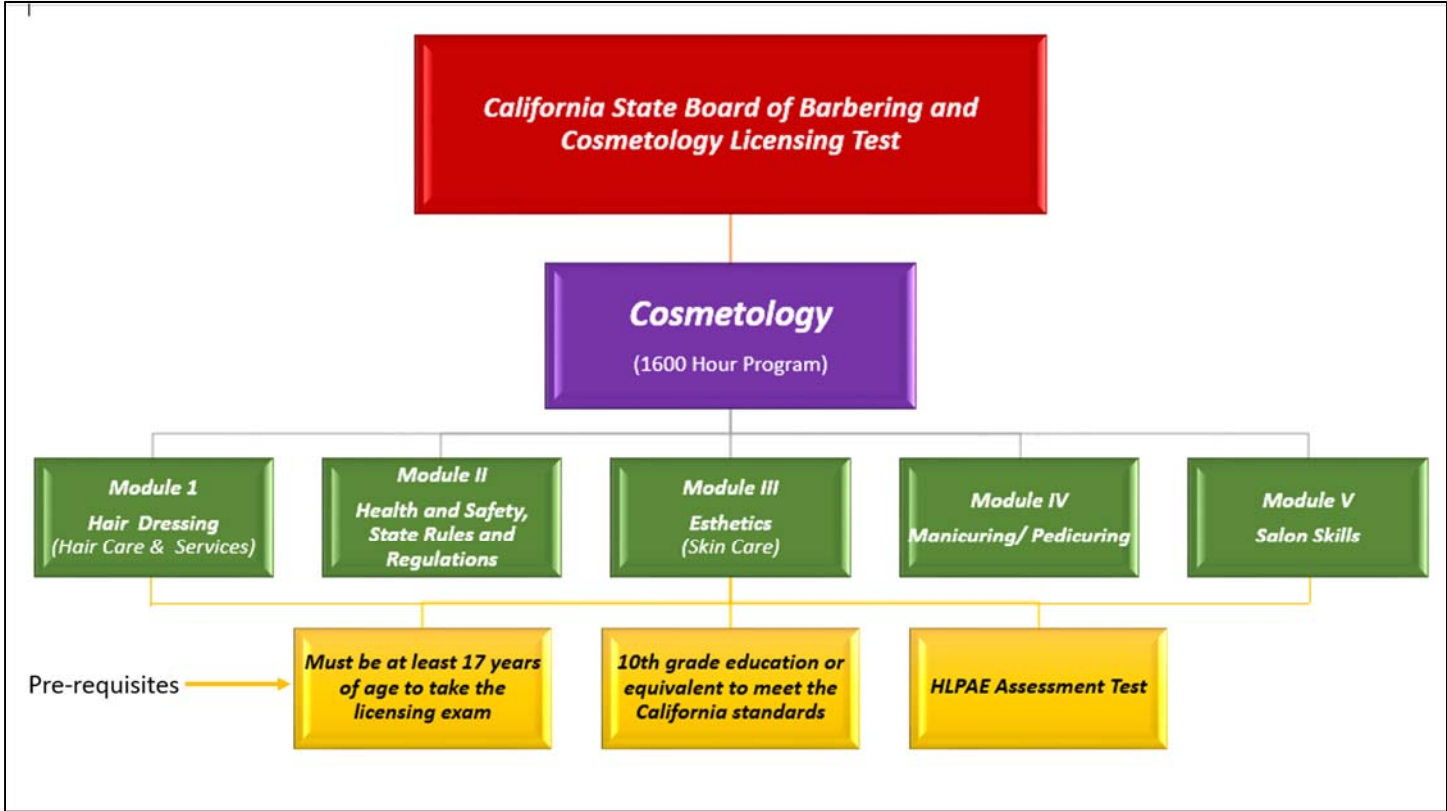

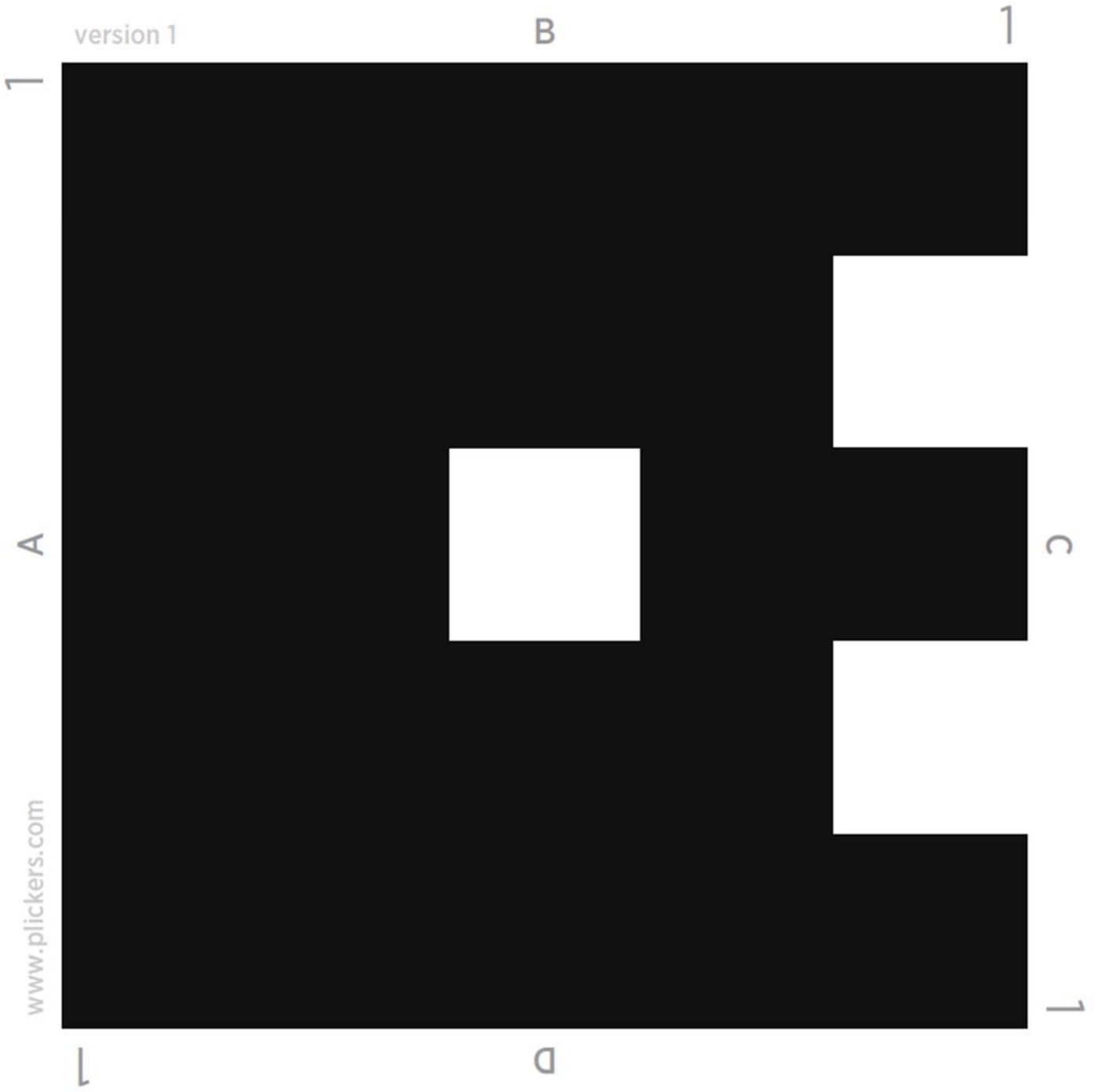
Plickers is a powerfully simple tool that lets teachers collect real-time formative assessment data without the need for students to have mobile devices. Get results fast and easy the use of QR (quick response) coded cards.

How to use Plickers:

1. Need plicker cards (can download and print in quantities of 40 or 63 – all free)
2. Each student is assigned a plicker card with a QR code and number printed on the card
3. Ask or display a question
4. Ask students to hold up the plicker card with their answer on top
5. Scan with a mobile device
6. Results are Live View and immediate

Advantages to Plickers:

- timesaving tool that provides teachers with instant formative or summative
- easy quick-to launch app
- no need for students to have smart devices or phones
- only one smart device is needed
- answers uploads immediately to screen
- get real time recorded answers for an entire class in seconds
- create questions as you go





Google Keep is a note taking application developed by Google. Capture what's on your mind, add notes, lists, photos, and audio. Use Keep as an OCR reader. Can't find soft copies of old document? Use Google Keep, just snap a picture of that document and convert to text for easy editing.

How to use the OCR feature of Google Keep:

1. Open Google Keep on your mobile device (can download)
2. Tap the camera icon in the bottom right corner
3. Tap Take Photo
4. Snap a photo of the image
5. Tap the check mark when you're happy with the photo (make sure of the clarity)
6. Tap photo
7. In the resulting window, tap the menu button (three vertical dots)
8. Tab Grab Image Text
9. Title the note
10. Edit the note as needed.
11. Tap the back button when don

Advantages of "Google Keep":

- Transcribes text from images or photos by using the Optical Character Recognition (OCR) feature
- Can take quick notes and lists on the go
- Records audio
- Creates pop-up reminders
- Optical character recognition (OCR) quickly digitizes text in files, so you can search for it using keywords almost immediately.
- Syncs new notes across devices at lightning speeds
- Allows for sharing lists with others, such as shopping lists
- An app that is a core Google application that is equal to gmail and Google Drive in Google's vision
- And, it's completely free

Google Slides



Create a new presentation and edit with others at the same time. Get stuff done with or without an internet connection. Use **Slides** to edit PowerPoint files.

How to use Google Slides:

1. Google Slides is part of Google Docs which located inside the Google Browser.
2. Sign into your Google Account
3. Open the app launcher
4. Select Google Docs
5. Open the Main Menu
6. Select Slides
7. To create a new presentation select Blank

Advantages of “Google Slide”

- Google Slides is on the cloud (with internet connection)
 - Can access any time and place
 - Cloud support allows for last minute adjustments
 - Can never accidentally delete that presentation even if the computer crashes.
- It is sharable instantaneously – only thing needed is an internet connection.
 - Makes group work a lot more convenient
 - Collaborate with others without being in the same place
- Make changes on same slide at same time with colleagues without losing anyone’s modifications
 - Built in message system (communicate via instant messaging as you work together)
- Transform old and plain presentation to vibrant and appealing presentations

Edmodo is dedicated to connecting all learners with the people and resources they need to reach their full potential. It like an on-line classroom – that does most the work for you.

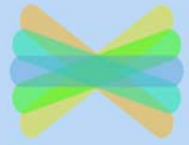
How to use Edmodo:

1. Setup your teacher account, a profile of yourself.
2. Give your students a group number to enroll.
3. Create quizzes, assignments due dates and auto grade posting.
4. Import videos, edit or change items when needed.
5. Notes to your students in group or individual.

How to use Seesaw:

1. Download App or visit the website <http://web.seesaw.me>
2. Create a free teacher account.
3. Create a classroom list (First and Last Names)
4. Invite by email or with QR Code
5. Ready for use: You and your students can add pictures, videos, links, notes, assignments etc. from any mobile device.

OneDrive is Microsoft's service for hosting files in the "cloud", that's available for free to all the owners of a Microsoft account. OneDrive offers users a simple way to store, sync and share all kinds of files, with other people and devices

How to use Microsoft OneDrive:

1. OneDrive is a part of Microsoft
2. Sign in to your Microsoft Account
3. Takes you directly to OneDrive
4. Open the App launcher that gives you access to Word, Excel, PowerPoint Online
