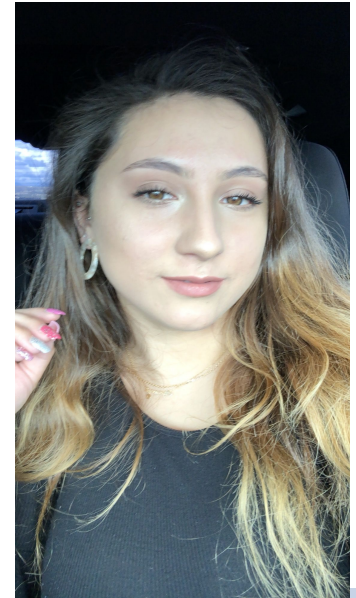


Emily Nunez, BAS Success Story



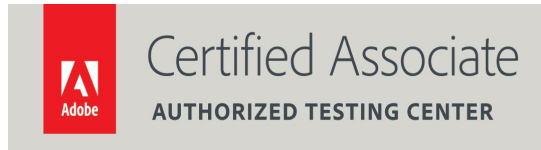

During his time at the Margett Pathway Academy, Angel was also enrolled in our Youth CareerConnect program where he was exposed to different hands on learning opportunities. Student Success Story

Celia Garcia Celia is not our average student. She is 54 years old. She began the Cosmetology program at our school when she was 52 years old because she had no choice.

“I’ve always loved hair. I remember I had two dolls with long hair when I was 8 or 9; these were no ordinary dolls. These dolls had the kind of hair that you could control its length by making it short or long. I would spend hours playing with their hair. Ever since then I wanted to become a Cosmetologist.”

Celia would have loved to take Cosmetology as an elective when she was in High School, but she couldn’t because she had to work to help support the family. Once she finished high school she got married, had children, and her dreams to become a Cosmetologist had to be placed on hold again.

“Now that my children are grown and out of the house, I can do what always I’ve wanted to do, which is become a Cosmetologist. That is why I am at the Pomona Cosmetology and Barbering program fulfilling my dream.”

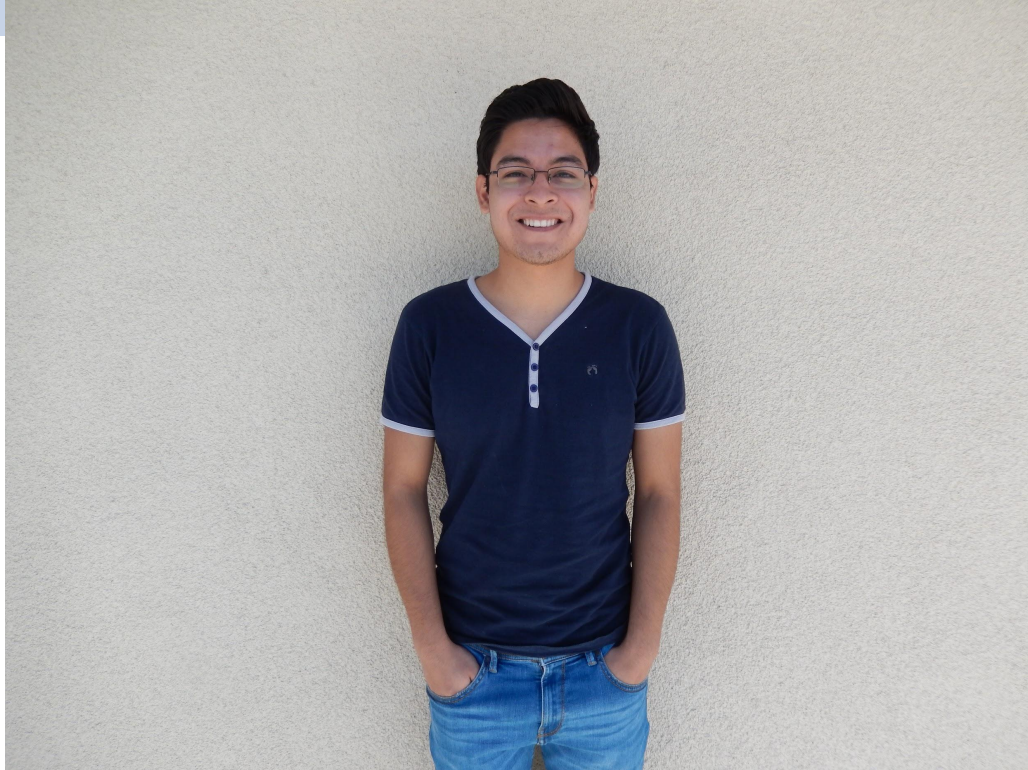
