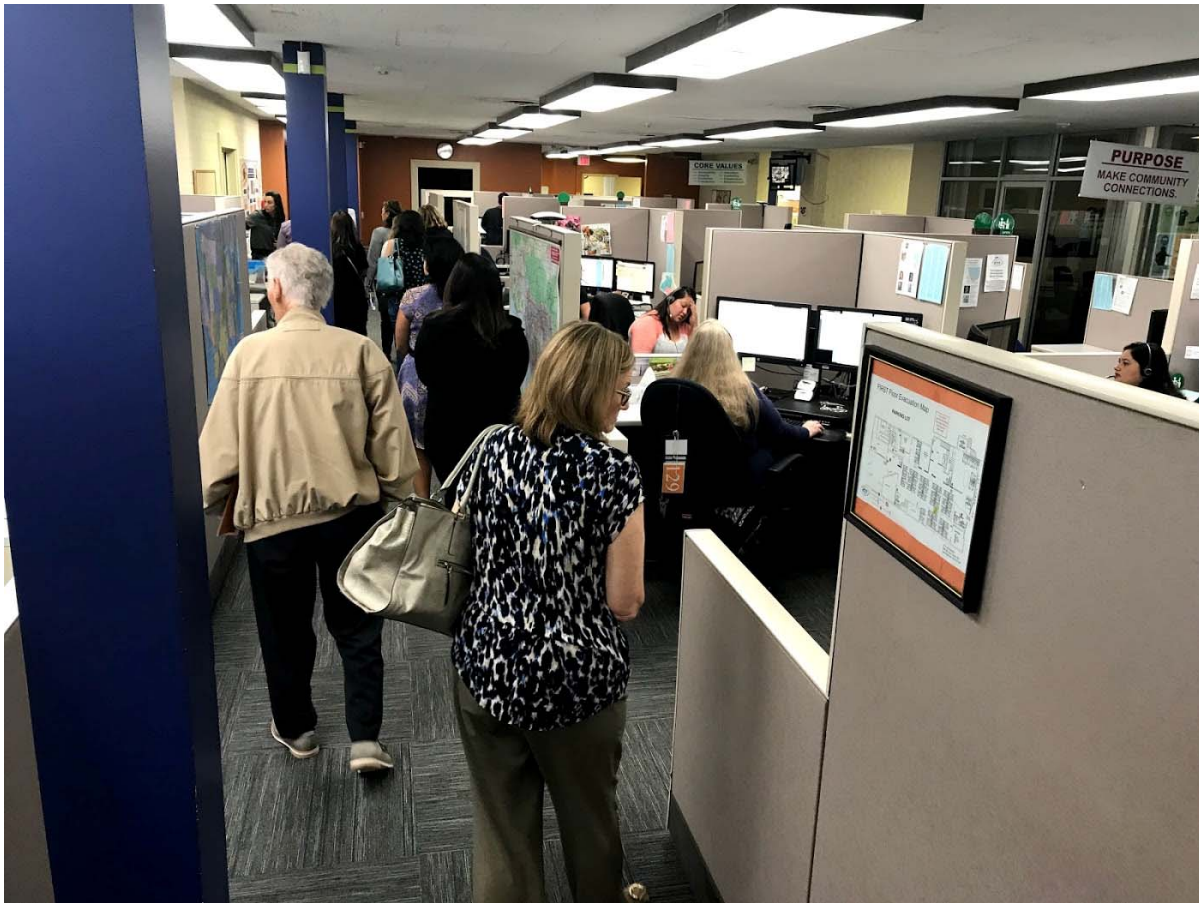
Mt. SAC School of Continuing Education Health Careers Job Fair

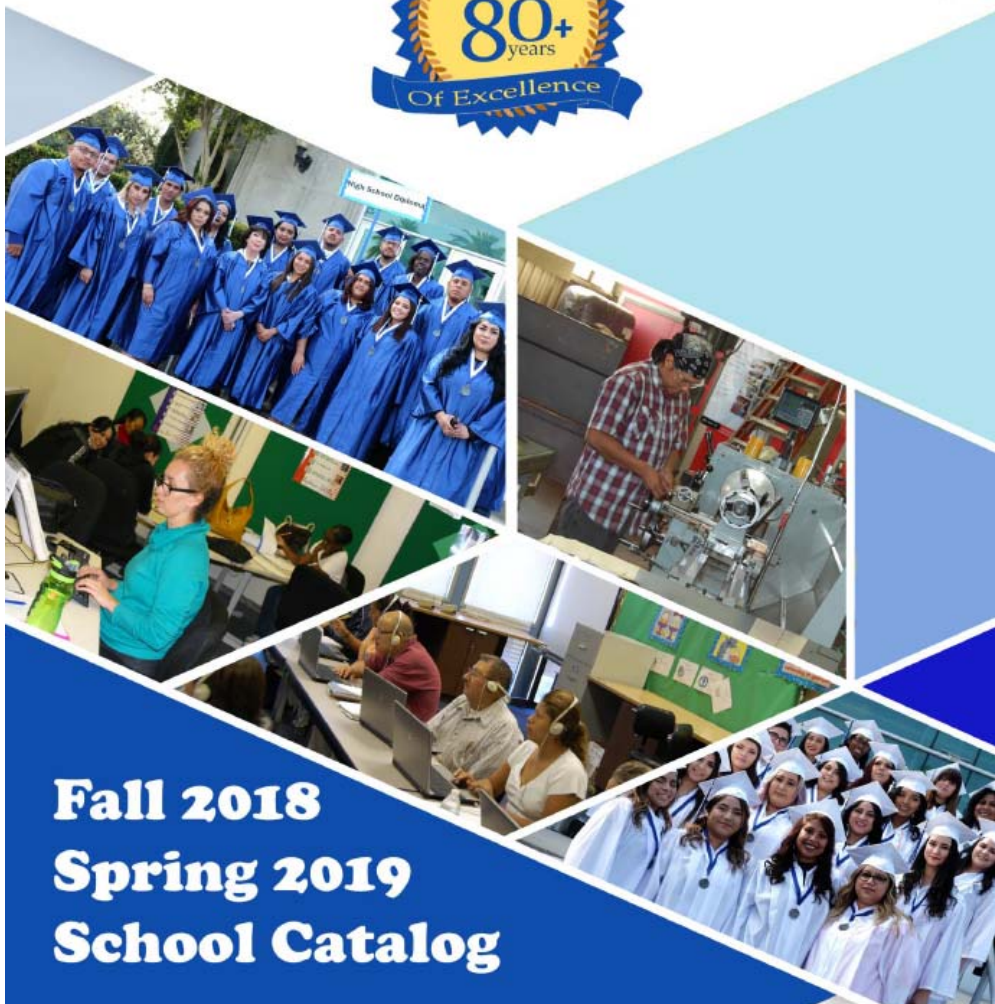
