Evaluation results from the Fall Conference Attempt to do online evaluation as well as paper. 15% completed survey on-line. Repeating sessions if they are very popular. Survey ahead of time and pre-integration registration. Statewide conference (400) did almost everything electronic. Registration and evaluation was all online. We are going to push the attendees to use technology. Push to do an online registration. Can select workshop levels. We will have preliminary numbers of workshops and it will allow us to select appropriate rooms. Can ask attendees would you like a copy of the handouts. Will ask people to bring their devices. Send out a pre information and get as much information as we can. Having a workshop within our work group to access our survey's online. MaryAnn will check with Raymond regarding internet connection. More conversation with topics of the areas. What could we focus and build on. More of technology. Number of teachers who haven't had any exposure to OTan or CalPro. Have them do direct presentations or have their peers present. Certain number of people, they will send someone out, free of charge to conduct staff development. Interactivity from the workgroup level and have members of the consortium lead the workshops. Focus on conference will be Tools for Student Success. What are the tools that will help teachers to do this? Technology integration. Ask teachers to bring it to the conference. This is how you do a survey on-line. Using online resources. Doesn't involve purchasing an expensive program but ways to use existing technology. Using social media to follow up with students. Be careful b/c of privacy issues and sensitive to those who are not documented. Have a conversation of use of social media. If you are going to do OTan, bring experts in here first, and can field questions and do workshop yourself. Experts will show you how to use it, but you will show the audience how you use it in your classroom. Doesn't have to be technology based. What other tools do you use that help critical thinking. Could be strategies that are more interactive (example role play) that is relevant to students. More focus on soft skills or elective type classes for your diploma program or working with some existing career tech. Use some of these funds to develop or do these types of programs. ESL and welding program. Cross programs (ESL) transition into diploma. What is the path way they need to follow? Where does the overlap happen? Crosswalk (showing what every district offers). There should be some annual complication from the Consortium a working manual, so that people will have a reference of alignment across the consortium. Concurrent enrollment with CTE program. We are starting to think of "our" students. Having this document and presenting our philosophy and showing them how to use this information of this document. Explain as a consortium works as a whole. This could be a session all by itself. Time constraint made it difficult to interact with one another. We need to network. Most successful workshops were those that were able to do that. Three sessions for about 50 minutes.
