1. Question	<p>Question: If a student tests in at a 234, and gets placed in a HSD/HSE program do you get a paypoint for a 236? Or not because they are already supposed to be at a high school level if they are in a HSD/HSE program. Students who test below a 236 need to be registered in a pre-diploma (ABE) program in order to get the paypoint at 236 for transition to HSD/HSE, right? Ryan will follow up on this.</p> <p>Answer: Yes, you will get a paypoint if they improve an EFL, even if they are enrolled in a HSD program and the EFL gain is below a 236.</p>
2. Prepare for Conference	<p>Alex reviewed his presentation on AEBG Outcomes and Metrics. He will add in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EFL Definition and Chart • CASAS Report Forms (with student data) <p>Alex’s CB 21 crosswalk will be distributed at the conference.
