<b>Minutes</b>  1. Reading and approval of minutes  2. Sharing work group homework	Meeting called to order 1:50 PM – facilitated by Mary Ann Gomez-Angel.  Minutes from 2/14/17 were reviewed and unanimously approved.  Work group members were asked to think about how to implement, or to implement, some of the technology discussed at the last meeting into their classroom.  Alex used crash course videos on American Government, google docs to collaborate with teachers, and CK12 to look at online textbooks.  Norm used Khan Academy and Algebra Help for math, Learn English Feel Good for ESL, and Crash Course videos.  Debbie and Peggy tried accessing the Mt. SAC Online courses about digital citizenship, but were unable to find them.

Future discussions</p>	<p>This work group and the consortium overall feels they are on track in terms of integrating technology in the classroom.</p> <p>There was discussion surrounding student persistence. Students must have clear goals in mind. Goal setting and persistence go hand in hand. It is important that big goals are broken down into smaller more manageable goals. There was also discussion on the differences between stopping out and dropping out. Work Group also discussed the role of the teachers vs. the counselors and the scope of practice of each. It is agreed that having a conversation with a student, teacher, and counselor present is important and can be helpful to the student. Mary Ann and Diana are going to look for data on this. There was emphasis on provided resources to students to help them overcome barriers.</p>
