 Cal-Pro Professional Learning Community (PLC) Institute)

Wanda and Sage discussed the Cal-Pro Professional Learning Community (PLC) Institute. Sage circulated an email and information form that will also be forwarded to the Counselors Work Group Contact List

"A professional learning community is educators committed to working collaboratively in ongoing processes of collective inquiry and action research to achieve better results for the students they serve."

"The Institute will consist of two face-to-face sessions, a moderate amount of online work, and site-based implementation of plans crafted by participating agency teams. The first face-to-face session will take place on May 01 and 02, 2017; the second face-to-face session will take place on October 2, 3, and 4, 2017. Both sessions will be held at the CALPRO office in Sacramento."

4. Mt. SAC Bridge Program

Current summer bridge program at Mt. SAC does not allow adult students.

Work group discussed if it would be more beneficial to have a bridge from the adult schools to college, or a bridge to their career. Work group also discussed if the bridge should take place at Mt. SAC or at the adult school sites. Most people felt that students go from High School Diploma/GED Programs to the workplace, although a few students do express interest in going to college. Yvette mentioned



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that even when the Mt. SAC Counselors enroll students in their first semester college classes, they often do not attend, and are dropped.

**Bassett Adult School** 

Currently, students do not take a career profile test. Members felt that this would be a useful tool. California Career Zone is a free tool that could be implemented for this purpose. Some felt that the career profiler should be sued at the beginning of a student's high school diploma program. Advantages to this are that the student will have to complete it to enroll, and that it will help them pick courses related to their career goals. Some felt that the career profiler should be used at the end of a program because they have had a chance to change and learn what they might be interested in, and they can get excited about their career. Valerie thought it might be a useful tool to use throughout their diploma program (beginning, middle, and end).

Mt. SAC could do a face-to-face orientation at the adult schools for students who are interested in going to college after receiving their high school diploma/GRE.

Follow up with students post-graduation is going to be an important part of funding. Wanda discussed this accountability. Adult schools will have to provide data on how many students go on to college, go on to get a job, or go on to be promoted. This data will eventually be required for all program areas. Currently, follow up with students is not great. Many schools only follow up with CTE students. Micah discussed LinkedIn as a useful tool for follow up. Students could be required to create a LinkedIn profile, and add the school to their network.
