Requested Definitions

Workforce Readiness:

General, not industry-specific

No hour requirement

Can be part of a CTE program

OSHA

Soft Skills

Short Term Vocational(STV)/Career Tech Education(CTE):

- Industry/Program specific workforce training:
- No specific hour requirement, but traditionally around 30-50+ hours or more
 - For I.E.T, usually 48+ hours
- *Welding*
- *EMT*
- *MA*
- *CNA*

Pre-Apprenticeship:

- Aligned to an apprenticeship program
- WR certifications
- Bring in apprenticeships to present
- Job skills
- Soft Skills
- Orientation to Apprenticeship
- MC3 (union trades) pre-apprenticeship package
- Adopted by the trades

Services and programs designed to prepare individuals to enter and succeed in Registered Apprenticeship programs. These programs have a documented partnership with at least one Registered Apprenticeship program sponsor and together, they expand the participant's career pathway opportunities with industry-based training coupled with classroom instruction.

Quality pre-apprenticeship programs are a starting point toward a successful career path for under-represented job seekers (such as disadvantaged women and men, individuals with disabilities and others) who may not be aware of this approach to obtain good jobs with opportunities for advancement. Pre-apprenticeships help individuals meet the entry requirements for apprenticeship programs and ensure they are prepared to be successful in their apprenticeship.

Apprenticeship:

- 144 Classroom Hours
- 1000-2000 hours/6 months On the Job training (or competency-based instruction)
- Difficult to approve the adult schools or noncredit level (aside from innovative ideas which are being approved and DAS approved)

Registered Apprenticeship is an employer-driven training model. Apprenticeship programs provide on-the-job learning from an experienced mentor and related classroom instruction on the technical and academic aspects of the job. The training is rooted in industry skill standards and competencies. Apprenticeship programs help companies successfully recruit, develop and retain a highly skilled workforce for the jobs they need filled. Registered Apprenticeship is the term used for apprenticeship programs that have a formal structure, in which employers have established learning standards that meet national and state quality expectations. When individuals successfully complete a Registered Apprenticeship program, they receive a national credential that is recognized anywhere in the industry.
