Student Progress Report	Suggestions for Progress Report:  • Translate form on the back to student's native language  • Create a lesson plan around the vocabulary and give examples  • Use CASAS Scale Score instead of CASAS raw score  Even if we do not make changes to the progress report based on every comment made by teachers, we need to at least discuss their suggestions.
4. Others	CASAS Reports Discussion: The most important CASAS reports for teachers are the "Individual Skills Profile" and the "Class Performance by Competency"
