4. EL Civics

When does your agency administer the Community Needs Assessment Survey?

All attending agencies confirmed they administered the EL Civics Needs Assessment Survey during spring semester, some in the middle some towards the end. Discussed the importance of administering the survey at times of highest enrollment to receive back meaningful data to support COAAP choices for the upcoming year.

Potential COAAP Curriculum Creation

Reviewed possible El Civics COAAPs for revision as a consortium. Reviewed Civic Objective: Transitions #50, #51, #52 and #53. After reviewing the individual plans (AAPs), group has decided to focus on CO #51 with the potential of either revising some of the language and literacy tasks currently offered or creating a AAP under CO# 51 for use of anyone in the consortium.

Also reviewed Workforce Training Health Care CO#71, which currently both Mt SAC and Tri-Community offer in 22-23. Workgroup was happy to hear that new literacy and language objectives had been added to CO# 71 but can see some potential for even further revision in the future.

Tischel brought up working on these revisions in the next meeting and will reach out to Lori Howard of CASAS to see if she can attend the next meeting to answer any questions we may have as a group and or to discuss options and limitations of revision/creation of COAAPs.

Tischel has since spoken to Lori and she will be able to attend the end of our next meeting in February.
