# Adult Basic/Secondary Education (ABE/ASE)

9/12/2017

Members reviewed and discussed LAUSD writing rubrics, CASAS EFLs, and the CAI. During the upcoming conference, members will discuss the AEBG Outcome Metrics and work on developing writing rubrics that align with CASAS.

## **Adults Training for Child School Success (ATCSS)**
